Subject: Replacement of Defibrillator Housing – Kilnsea

Following a recent incident at Kilnsea it has been brought to my attention that the existing Defibrillator Housing code entry system is not working. I have been to have a look and the existing box whilst usable without a locking system at the moment will need replacing.

Option 1 - Currently the box in situ is the - Aivia 210 AED Cabinet Digicode Protected with Audible Alarm & Heating, this had a 1-year warranty and actually is quite flimsy. The cost to replace 'like for like' being £473.00 plus VAT.

Option 2 - AED Armor Polycarbonate Outdoor Locked Cabinet with heating, this has a 10-year warranty, but note does not have an Alarm and the cost for this cabinet is £495.00 plus VAT.

Option 3 - AED Armor Polycarbonate Outdoor Locked Cabinet with heating and Alarm, again this has a 10-year warranty, but does have an Alarm, the cost for this cabinet is £545.00 plus VAT.

There are also options of 'No Lock' cabinet(s) but this would of course mean that anyone could walk away with a defibrillator.

Taking all of the above into account I would personally recommend either Option 2 or Option 3, I have selected the polycarbonate type box due to the elements faced at the location. In addition to the defibrillator housing, it would need to be 'hard wired' by an approved Electrical Installer.

Could you please take some time to research the options, I have used The Defib Shop as this has been our usual supplier.

I will add the subject to the Agenda for July for discussion or all options.

Finally, this will be outside our 'budget' for defibrillator, which is already spent this year, so we will have to use some budget from elsewhere to fund or take from reserves if we replace the box.
