Grass cutting contract applications – Discussion and resolution for agreement for 2018, work to commence the first week of April and run until weekending 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2018 – 13 cuts in total. – One quote has been received and due to current financial projections it was suggested that 13 cuts for the year would need to be adhered to. The total for this amount of cuts is £3,900 on the current quotation.

It was agreed for Street scene to continue with the cutting and then stagger the cuts to maintain the target spend.

Cllr Graham has raised two highways issues pertaining to Hull Road & road, leading to Dimlington Bungalows – The Clerk to follow up with ERYC.
