1. 2. Public Forum

Kim Dalton: The defib had been needed over the weekend and it was noted that the person felt they lacked the confidence and knowledge to use it – could some information be added to the newsletter – The clerk to arrange but stressed that the first priority was to contact the emergency services and follow their instructions.

Andrea Clubley: the grass along the verge on Seaside Road was very long and had not been cut in quite some time. Cllr Clubley said that none of the verges had been cut yet. The Clerk to query when the work would be carried out.

3. Ward Councilor Tucker

The meeting regarding erosion and prospect of losing the road to Withernsea had taken place and Cllr Tucker thanked Cllr Longhorn for attending. This matter is very important and Cllr Tucker urged the PC to become more involved and if possible write to Jake Berry about the issue. If the road goes, access for everyone will be effected including emergency service access etc. The utilities which run under the road will also be effected – this is a really serious risk to the Parish.

Email – Withernsea Town Council – Confirmation of Mayor Terry Dagnall, Mayoress Sally Dagnall and Deputy Mayor Lyn Healing.

Email – Cliffe Farm request for placement of further bollards at the corner adjacent to the Crown at Kilnsea. The Clerk would contact ERYC again about the replacement of the damaged bollards and request some more to ensure cars could not park on the land. Cllr I Smith suggested extending the raised kerb could be an option?
