

EASINGTON COMMUNITY HALL REPORT 2022 FOR PARISH COUNCIL AGM

The Hall continued to function during the pandemic being used for essential services of Post Office and Fareshare -which supplies food to the community.

Fareshare returned back to the church in May 2021, when churches were allowed to reopen.

The Hall started to reopen in June 2022 with a small steps approach under COVID safe restrictions. Thursday Coffee Mornings participants were the first to be welcomed back, closely followed by the Saturday Coffee Mornings.

The Hall is now fully open and in use by a few local organisations ie MOD, Craft Club, Parish Council. The committee looks forward to welcoming back all the organisations who used the Hall pre-pandemic, when they are ready.

The Jubilee Committee have also used the Hall over the last year to raise fund to provide the Parish with a Jubilee Celebration in June 2022. The Hall was given free of charge to raise money for the one-off event. The Afternoon Teas have proven to be a great success, with parishioners requesting more of these events throughout the year.

The Hall has had a few minor maintenance issues recently – leaking taps that had to be replaced, a few door dampers that had broken – All have now been replaced/repared by the volunteers of the committee.

All safety checks have been completed for 2022 - Alarm, Fire Safety, Heating, Gas/Electric.

The Hall received some external damage to the noticeboard on the front of the Hall building recently. Replacement Perspex is being sourced and will be replaced once received.

The Hall Committee are holding their AGM on 18.5.2022 and would like to extend the invitation to attend to anyone in the Parish.

I would like to take the opportunity to thank the Hall Committee Volunteers for all their hard work, ongoing support and willingness to fix or find a solution to a problem. As only a small group a lot of work is achieved together.
