GASSCO

Meeting - Wednesday 8th June 2022 - 18:30 - The Community Hall

Gassco are currently preparing a planning application for constructing a new administration building on land it owns to the South of its Langede Receiving Facility on Dimlington Road in Easington, which you may already be aware of if you attend the Gas Terminals Community meetings.

The new building is proposed to create an enhanced working environment and provide facilities to replace the existing administration, security, and storage facilities on the current site in order to maintain and secure energy supplies in an effective manner as well as providing continued job security for the local community. Existing staff will be relocated from the existing building to the new building on completion.

As part of the development a new access road will be created from Dimlington Road to serve the new building which will be located to the rear of the site.

The Parish Council and residents will obviously be consulted by East Riding Planners as a part of the planning application process, but Gassco LRF would value the opportunity to present the proposals to you all and to explain the purpose and need for the proposed development.

We will welcome any questions during the meeting and listen to any feedback you may wish to provide.
