It is important to the continued presence of the church building in Easington, and its' work in the community, that people are willing to contribute to the administration. Throughout South Holderness there is a problem- with finding people willing to hold office in churches and help with the day to day running of them. Easington is very, very fortunate in having younger people willing to come on board with this.

In the past twelve years, Easington has been unique in presenting confirmation candidates to the bishop at every single confirmation service. Thanks to all who had the courage to take part in this, at St Matthews Church, in Withernsea. Confirmation services take place every two years and we are hoping to start a group shortly, ready for the next one. If you want to find out what is involved, don't hesitate to get in touch and find out.

We continue to hold FareShare sessions on Fridays 11am - 1pm. All are welcome. It's not a food bank. You choose your food and contribute towards it.

There is a charity shop for ministry funds in the Crossroads Nursery at Hollym. If you have second goods you no longer require, they can be donated to fund the services of priests in the deanery of South Holderness.
